Job Summary:

The Engineering Manager will be responsible for the development and management of engineering activities and operations relating to the planning, design, and construction management of improvements to the District's water distribution, storage, and treatment systems. The scope of responsibilities includes management of capital improvements, developer extensions, major rehabilitations, and emergency response repair. This position will also administer consultant contracts and manage consultants during design and construction. The Engineering Manager will be responsible for the development and maintenance of engineering standards and policies and will participate in the overall planning and management of the District as a member of the management team. This position will provide work assignments, instruction, and supervision to the GIS Coordinator, Construction Inspector, and other personnel as assigned.
