Formed in 1943, the District currently owns and operates 256 miles of water mains, 13 water tanks, 32 wells, six water treatment facilities, and serves more than 60,000 retail customers in Lakewood, WA and 55,000 wholesale customers.

Job Summary:

The Water Utility Worker II is responsible for the on-site maintenance and operation of the District's water distribution and treatment systems, physical plants, tanks, and reservoirs. This position will assist in training other employees in utility operations and maintenance activities and participate in the maintenance of electronic equipment and systems. The Water Utility Worker II will perform varied manual work and operate heavy and specialized equipment to maintain and/or repair water distribution and water treatment systems.

- 3-5 years progressively responsible experience in the maintenance, repair, and operation of a water distribution system of a public utility or comparable construction experience; any equivalent combination of education and experience that provides the applicant with the knowledge, skills, and abilities required to perform the job
