Dear Customer,

Lakewood Water District has recently adopted a new program to benefit our customers who require annual backflow prevention assembly testing. The District has contracted with Blake's Backflow Service LLC this year to provide a coordinated testing program at a charge of \$27.00 per assembly. This charge covers the testing of your assembly and the District's administrative costs for the program.

This is a voluntary program; you can elect to continue to select and hire your own backflow tester each year, or you can sign up for our program and have that service automatically provided for you by the District's contractor.

Blake's Backflow will be notified at the beginning of the month your test is normally due to schedule and perform the test. Only if you have an assembly located inside your home or business will an appointment be necessary and for someone to be present on site at the time of the testing. Blake's Backflow will inspect, test, and certify your backflow assembly. If simple cleaning or flushing is needed, it will be included in this service, along with re-testing and certification, all for the \$27 charge. If the backflow assembly is in need of major repair i.e. replacement parts, or is beyond repair, you will be notified to arrange and pay for those repairs and /or the assembly's replacement.

You will be billed on your next bi-monthly water service bill after the testing, providing convenience as well as cost savings. Enclosed you will find a form (Automatic Backflow Testing and Right of Entry Agreement) with some additional information. Please look it over, fill in the pertinent information, and return the form to the District office within 30 days so that our contractor can plan accordingly.

Again, this is a voluntary program, and you may opt in or out at any time. If you have further questions or need more information, feel free to call me at the number below or e-mail me at sjorgensen@lakewoodwater.org. We look forward to hearing from you.
